Additionally, **a \$1,000** scholarship is available for an adult who meets the same requirements graduating from Adult and Community Education (RACE).

David and Teri Malkin created the David and Teri Malkin Humanitarian Scholarship to honor their son Mathew, a graduate of RUSD who is currently working as a physician at a well-known teaching hospital. The Malkins have lived in Rowland Heights since 1974. Both attended UCLA—David became a social worker, while Teri became a High School Teacher. Their backgrounds inspired them to set up this scholarship for students interested in pursuing careers in helping professions.

Eligibility:

High school senior with a minimum 3.0 GPA (Students with a GPA lower than a 3.0 must have shown growth and have a teacher, counselor, or principal recommendation); Student must participate in school and community service beyond the minimum graduation requirements. Student is planning to attend a college, university or trade school. The Adult Education student must be on track to complete the full program in good standing and also must also be planning to enter a “helping” profession.
