School Description and Accreditation

John A. Rowland High School is a four-year comprehensive high school in the Rowland Unified School District with an enrollment of 1,997 students. Each class period is 56 minutes long, meets 5 days a week, 18 weeks per semester. We are accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, and we are a Gold Ribbon School, California Distinguished School, and a National Blue Ribbon School. We have 5 counselors with a 420:1 counselor-to-student ratio. In March 2020 we transitioned to a virtual setting with a Hold Harmless grading policy due to COVID. For the 2020-21 school year, students were still in a virtual learning environment. For the 2021-2022 school year, students returned to campus for in-person instruction.
